Call for Nominations

CIMVHR exists to enhance the lives of Canadian military personnel, Veterans and their families by harnessing the national capacity for research. CIMVHR is committed to building the field of military, Veteran and family health research by mobilizing efforts among Canadian and global researchers in collaboration with government, industry, philanthropy and other stakeholders.

In 2016, CIMVHR established a fellowship initiative to recognize leading experts who demonstrate exceptional research advancements within the field of military, Veteran and family health and well-being. To date, CIMVHR has identified seven fellows who promote CIMVHR within communities of researchers, clinicians and policy makers across Canada.

Fellow responsibilities may include:

- Promoting CIMVHR's mission within communities of researchers and policy makers;
- Inspire participation and leadership in CIMVHR scientific activities;
- Outreach and engagement with researchers and policy makers to extend CIMVHR presence in their region; and
- Encourage development through research networks that will benefit Veterans and military personnel and their families through membership of trainees by attracting new talents to the field.

Eligibility criteria:

- Fellows must have a primary affiliation with one of CIMVHR's university members;
- Fellows may represent any discipline and research area within CIMVHR's network; and
- Self-nominations will be accepted.

CIMVHR is now accepting nominations for 2018 fellows

Eligible candidates may submit a nomination that includes:

1. A two-page document summarizing the candidate's record, including:
 - a. candidate information (including: name, address, telephone, e-mail, preferred language, institutional affiliation, department, keywords);
 - b. research advancements that have been made within the field of military, Veteran and family health and well-being;
 - c. history of engagement with CIMVHR events, including but not limited to: MVFH Forum, and regional or thematic workshops; and
 - d. participation in CIMVHR peer reviewing activities.
2. A CV (in any format, but a CCV is preferred).
